Radium Girls to film at Wiawaka, Cozy Nook Cottages in LG

Radium Girls, a film based on the unknown poisoning of women factory workers in the 1920s, will start shooting today, Thursday, Oct. 6, in and around Lake George.

The film's producer, Cine Mosaic from Manhattan, is renting Cozy Nook Cottages on Ellsworth Road in Lake George and plans to film scenes there and at Wiawaka Center for Women.

Cine Mosaic produced *Queen of Katwe*, which is in theaters now, and is producing Oprah Winfrey's HBO Film *The Immortal Life Of Henrietta Lacks*.

Lydia Dean Pilcher, founder of Cine Mosaic, also produced HBO's *You Don't Know Jack* and Matt Damon's *The Talented Mr. Ripley* (1999).

We contacted Cine Mosaic last week but a spokeswoman declined comment.

A press kit says: "Inspired by a blending of historical scope with modern storytelling, *Radium Girls* will weave 1920s archival footage into original live action scenes to immerse viewers in the world.

"This innovative, unique visual style will

push the boundaries of conventional storytelling and create a new language for cinematic exploration of history.

"...The real life Radium Girls didn't get the justice they deserved, although they changed public perception in New Jersey, radium dial painting continued across America.

"By telling their story, we can continue the legacy started by the few brave workers who fought to bring the truth to light nearly 100 years ago."

The film was to conduct a casting call on Tuesday, Oct. 4, and Wednesday, Oct. 5, at the Queensbury Hotel.
